South Warwickshire plan: Stratford-on-Avon District Council and Warwick District Council are commencing on the preparation of a single Local Plan for both Districts . It is anticipated that this South Warwickshire Plan will replace the strategic policies in the existing adopted Stratford-on-Avon District Core Strategy and Warwick District Local Plan and run beyond 2031. To assist in the preparation of the South Warwickshire Plan, the Councils are setting up a number of advisory groups to help inform the content of the Plan. The intention is that these groups will meet at key stages throughout the Plan's preparation. Ahead of formal consultation on a scoping and initial options paper in Spring 2021 we would like to introduce the South Warwickshire Plan and provide you with an opportunity to identify any key issues facing future development in South Warwickshire.
