Housing Needs Survey

The Council feel that this is an opportune time to review any evidenced needs for Great Wolford and also to undertake a survey for Little Wolford. As well as using the survey to identify any specific housing needs for residents, the Council will also be including some pertinent questions that may help in creating a Parish Plan. It is hoped that WRCC (Warwickshire Rural Community Council will have the surveys ready for hand delivery to all households by mid November- if you arre able to help with the distribution please get in touch. Freepost envelopes are included and WRCC will collate the information and report back findings to the Council. Such evidence can be particularly useful in dealing with planning matters.





The Save the Fox and Hounds Campaign have been granted a High Court Hearing for the Judicial Review of application 22/03071/FUL. The substantive High Court hearing has been listed for 18th November at the Royal Courts of Justice, London. The start time of the hearing will be confirmed the day before. As many supporters as possible are welcomed to attend. The public galleries can be opened to accommodate people travelling to the court and good attendance would clearly demonstrate the public interest in this hearing and in saving the pub. Travel by train from Moreton is the recommended transport mode.

Caring for wildlife. A resident has recently reported finding a dead Red Kite and Owl, both of which are believed to have been victims of secondary poisoning from dead rodents. There are various alternative humane traps that can be used to try and limit infestations so please see if these work before resorting to poisioned bait and causing unintended harm to other predators.
